JOB GOAL: Provide instruction to students with disabilities aimed at achieving benchmarks determined by the State of Michigan

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Work cooperatively with classroom teachers who have students with disabilities in their general education classes, diagnosing and interpreting student abilities and assisting with appropriate prescriptive objectives.
2. Confer frequently with parents and professionals regarding cognitive, affective, and psychomotor challenges of students.
3. Facilitate all IEP meetings of assigned students.
4. Work cooperatively with support staff assigned to the department.
5. Provide appropriate materials to teachers, aides, and parents of students with disabilities.
6. Assist counselors that work with students with disabilities in making realistic assessment of their abilities in establishing educational and occupational goals that meet their needs.
